Kangaroos

Kangaroos are **marsupials**, which means they are mammals that have an external pouch or pocket.

Marsupials are different from most mammals because they give birth to very undeveloped young.

Joeys are born hairless and tiny, about the size of a bean and must climb their way up into their mother's pouch. They remain here to feed and sleep — in six months they grow to be 2,000 times the size they were at birth.

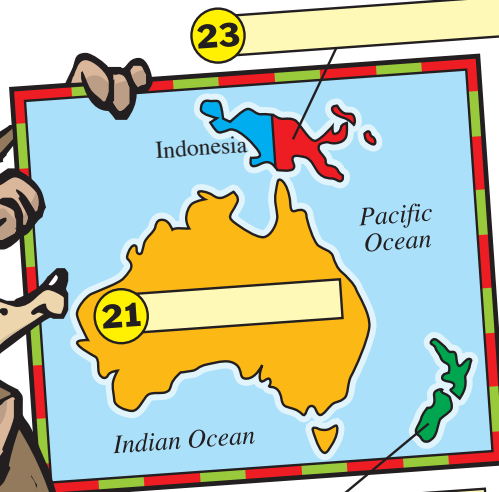

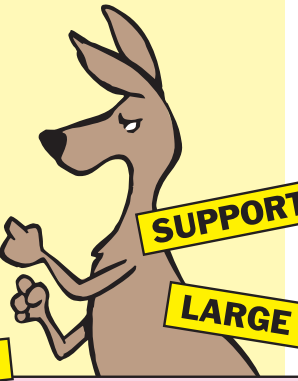

Jumping News

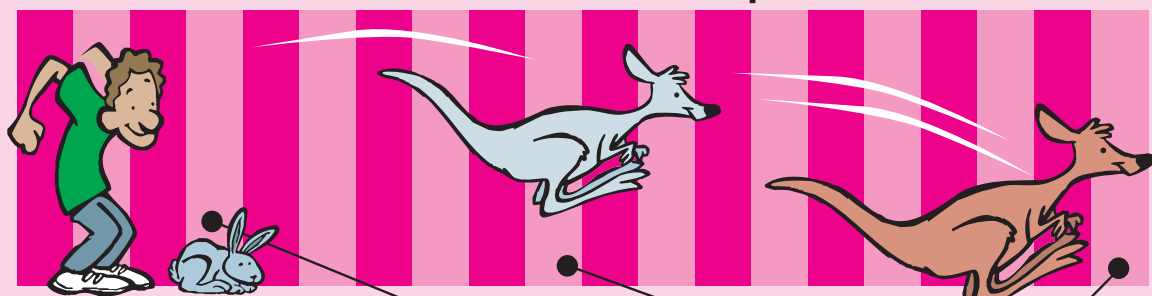
In a newspaper, a "jump" is a story that jumps from one page, usually the front page, to another. How many jumps can you find in today's newspaper?

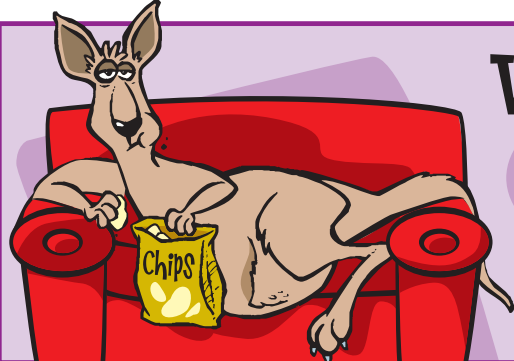
