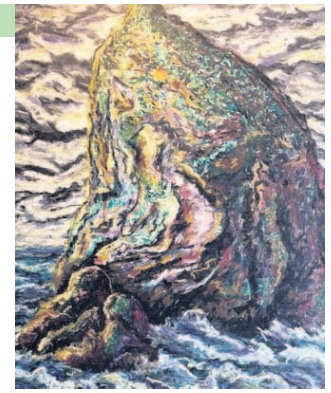

A 4-foot by 5-foot oil painting of Haystack Rock by Jeff Whyman.

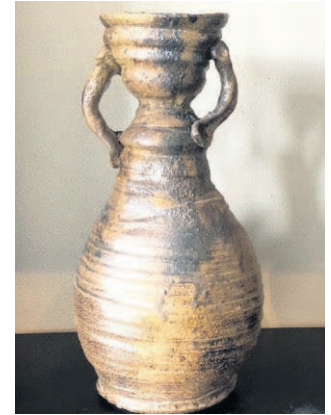
