8. Oscar d'Masai Studio & Gallery

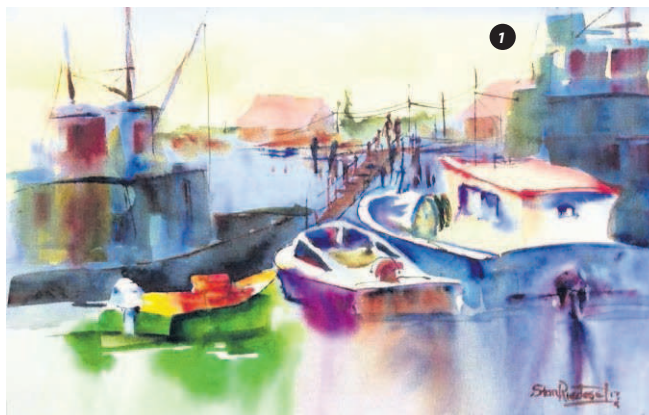

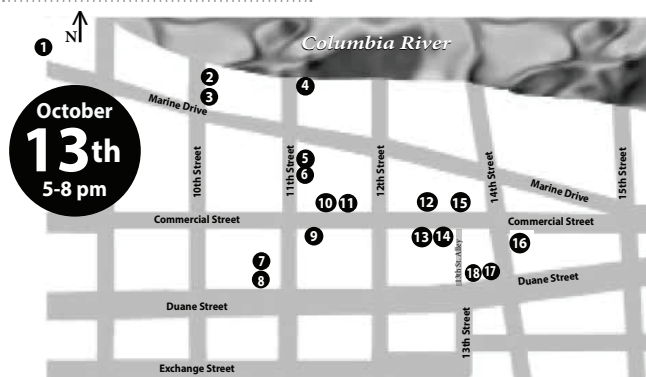
