### 11. Oscar d'Masi Studio & Gallery 395 11th St.

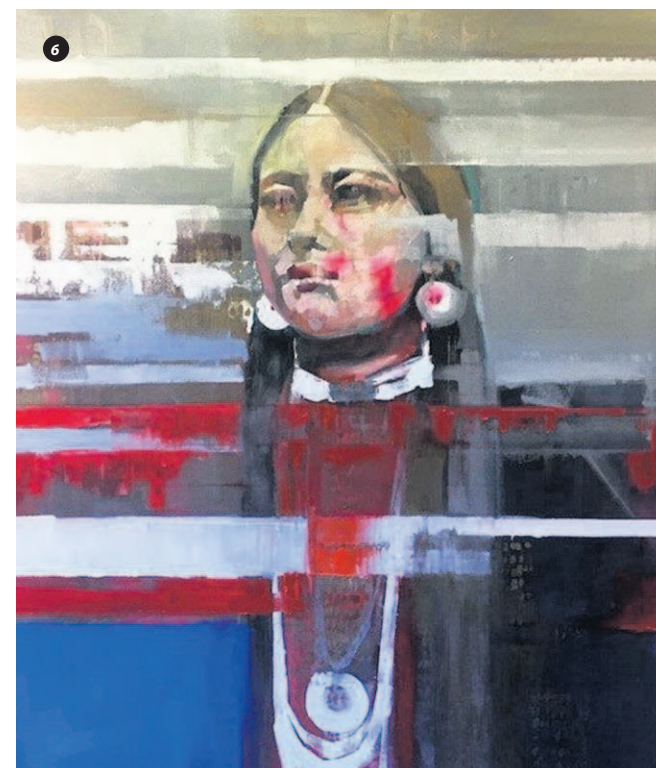
Visit with the artist in his studio. Landscapes, portraits and abstracts on display for purchase.
