A copy of the application, applicable criteria, documents, and evidence relied upon by the applicant are available for review at no charge. Likewise, a staff report will be available for inspection 7 days prior to the hearing. These materials can be reviewed at the Community Development Department. Copies of these materials will be provided at a reasonable cost.

Failure to raise an issue at the meeting, in person, or in writing, or failure to provide sufficient details to afford the Planning Commission and the applicant an opportunity to respond to the issue may preclude appeal to the Land Use Board of Appeals on that issue.
