CANNON BEACH – This year's annual Fourth of July Cannon Beach Library Book Sale kicks off Thursday, July 4, and runs through Sunday, July 7 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The library will close Wednesday, July 3, to organize the sale.

The sale has been happening for more than 30 years and is among the largest used-book sales on the Oregon coast. It is also a fundraiser for the private, member-owned, nonprofit library.


"This year's fundraiser offers thousands of novels, mysteries, biographies, histories, children's books, rare and old books and cooking, art and coffee-table books at bargain-basement prices," Library Board Member Janet Bates said.

She expects this year's sale to surpass last year's record contribution to the

library's annual budget. "To the thousands of popular fiction and nonfiction books donated this past year," Bates notes, "this sale also includes first editions, autographed copies and rare old books overlooked during our Third Annual Memorial Day Weekend Rare & Old Book Sale."
