

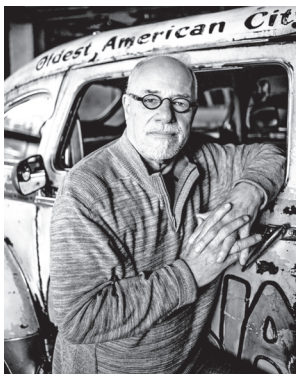
Regatta Pit Party

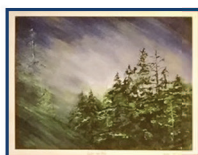
