Change your Diet

STICK TO RECOMMENDED SERVINGS

Even healthy foods should

be eaten with a serving limit in mind. Check out these new guidelines from the American Heart Association for people over 60 years of age:

five servings of vegetables per day; four servings of fruit per day; and eight to nine servings of meat per week.
