PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Knappa Schools Foundation (KSF) was founded in 1997. The KSF mission statement is *"To provide resources to enhance education and encourage individual success for the students of Knappa Schools."* Funds raised through the annual dinner and auction have been used in a three-point approach to fulfilling our mission statement. First, KSF awards scholarships each year to deserving students entering that critical first year of post-secondary education. Secondly, KSF awards mini-grants to teachers and educators to encourage innovation in the classroom and to enhance access to technology. Lastly, since its inception, KSF continually invests portions of the fundraising proceeds. These invested assets will provide support for Knappa students into perpetuity.

FUNDRAISING

Our Annual Dinner/Auction is our main fund raising event taking place on the second Saturday of February every year. It is held at our local high school gym which is beautifully transformed into a gala event. We open the doors at 4:30 Saturday afternoon and everyone comes early for appetizers and previews the silent, oral and raffle items. Together we enjoy a delicious dinner and the fun begins with the live auction. It is a huge successful event that reminds us all of what a community can do when they work together.
