ASTORIA — Jazz musician John Dover will perform at 7 p.m. on Feb. 27.

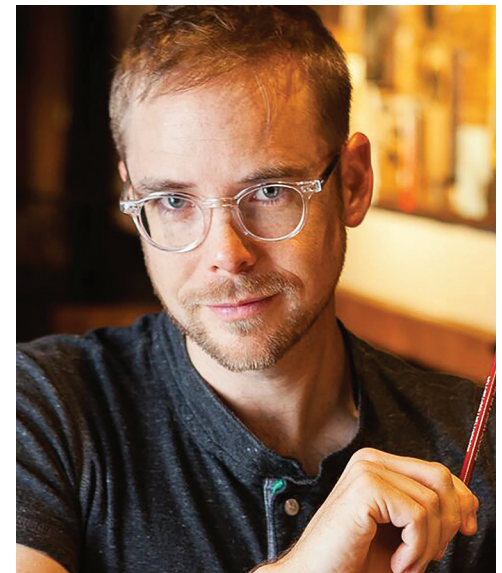
The performance will be the second of the North Coast Winter Jazz Gala's two-day celebration. On Wednesday, Dover performed with Astoria High School's jazz band and choir.
