As a former food photographer, she’s had the chance to work overseas and capture farmers, winemakers and other artisans doing just that. She hopes to someday go on Astoria’s local fishing boats to photograph life on the boat. “I am so intrigued by the craftsmanship on the coast,” DeViney said. “I know the right opportunities will naturally reveal themselves.”
