PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The South Pacific County Technical Rescue (SPCTR) is an all-volunteer organization which performs cliff and surf rescue, as well as beach safety education on the Long Beach Peninsula. We are made up of local volunteers who have undergone extensive training in order to assist people in their time of need. Our team was founded in 1978 to perform cliff rescues. In 1985, the team began doing surf rescues. In 2003, they initiated a beach safety program.

SPCTR is funded through grants and private donations. This money provides equipment, training, insurance, and supplies needed to perform rescue work.

SPCTR is always needing financial support. The team also accepts new volunteers.
