3. The Natural Nook, 738 Pacific Way

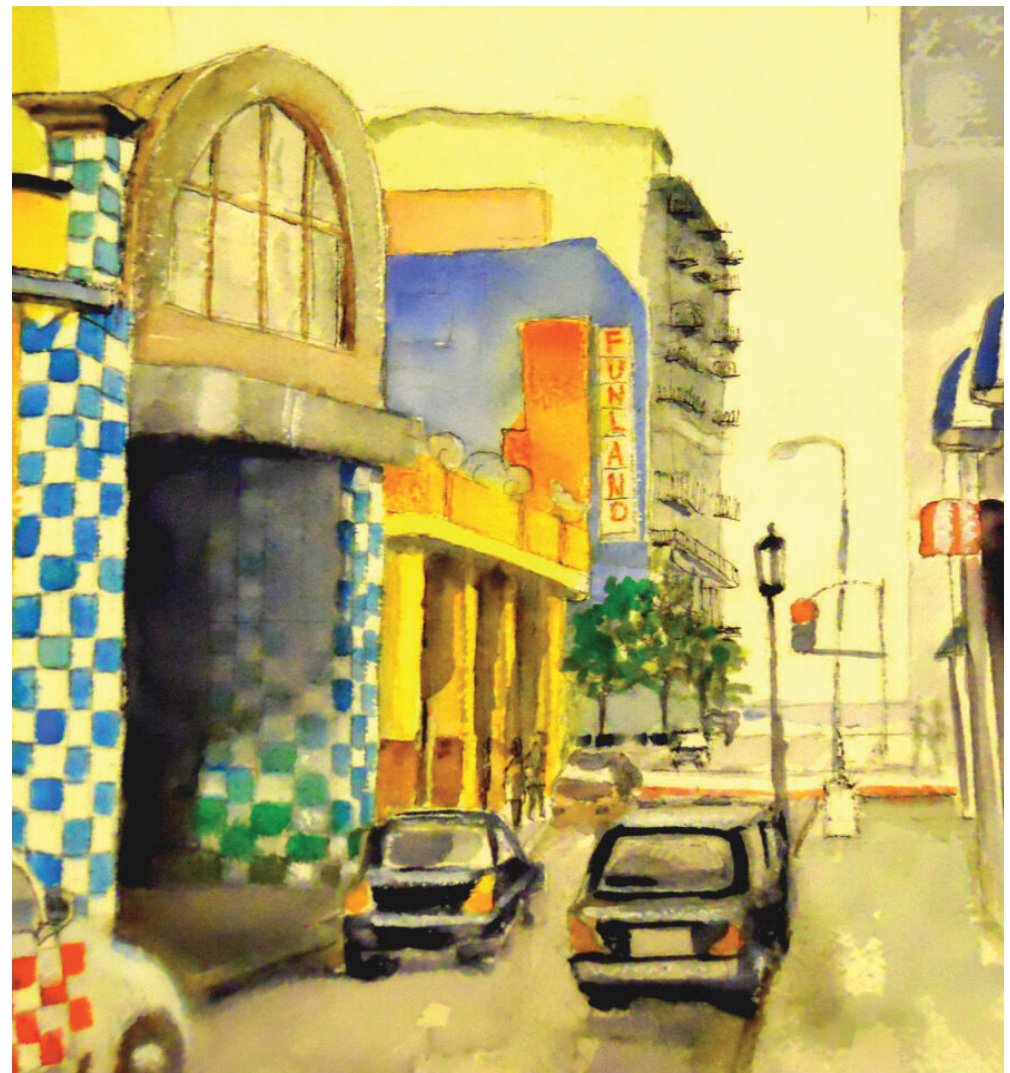
Showcasing more than 20 consignment artists’ new work.
