Featuring new credit card mosaics by Mari Cardinal Walker; quilted paintings by Ronni Harris; and jewelry by new artisan jeweler Jenny Coakley.

2. Pacific Heirloom Art and Collectables, 608 Broadway St.

Presenting antique model ships that encase maritime history and show intricate details. Ship modeling became popular in the 1920s. Ship models of the era comprise a combination of wooden hulls and

cast lead for anchors, deadeyes and rigging blocks.
