8. Brumfield Gallery, 1033 Marine Drive

Presenting artist Ruth Hunter, who paints abstracted figures, created of color fields built up in layers of expressive mark making. Ceramic sculptures created by Kelsey Bowen will also be displayed.

9. Imogen Gallery, 240 11th St.

Featuring “Mysterium,” a collection of new acrylic paintings created by Bethany Rowland. In the collection, Rowland “cultivates and shares contemplative peace, utilizing imagery of wildlife she offers suggestion of acceptance for the unknown.”

10. Astoria Institute of Music and Center for the Arts, 1159 Marine Drive

Showcasing new local artists Cicely Gilman, who creates digital art and collages, and Ivan Sultan, who handcrafts silver chainmail jewelry. Also featured are resident artists TKO, Paul Gagnon, Sid Deluca and Lisa Ackerman. Vintage items will be for sale and information on music lessons will be available. 11. Ashriver Woodworks, 229 14th St.

Presenting Ashriver Woodworks, a new family-run business that specializes in epoxy river tables and reclaimed furniture. Artists design one-of-a-kind custom wood and metal pieces. Handmade home décor is sourced locally and created in Astoria.

12. Lumen: Community Wellness, 1350 Exchange St.

Showcasing art by Kristen Nekovar, who is a new painter who is finding her voice as an artist. Nekovar’s work “wears its heart on its sleeve. Sometimes the sleeves are lace and sometimes they are armor.”

13. Bridge & Tunnel Bottleshop & Taproom, 1390 Duane St.

Featuring work by Jasper Stone, who is a self-taught painter. Stone’s work is inspired by the Redwoods at Humboldt State University and aims to “transmute happiness and a sense of calm with wonder by using bright colors and high contrast.” Stone also creates cosmic-inspired acrylic pours and small black ink drawings.

Showcasing the show “Fierce Grace,” which includes paintings by Samyak Yamauchi. The paintings are a tribute to pet
