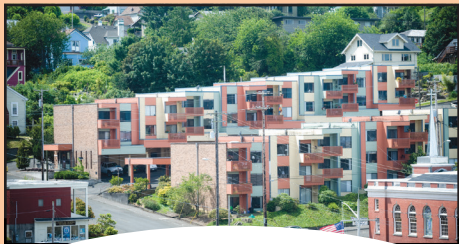
8. Foragers, 1004 Marine Drive

Roy Sanchez's 'Adeline and Tamyra' is featured at Astoria Institute of Music and Center for the Arts.

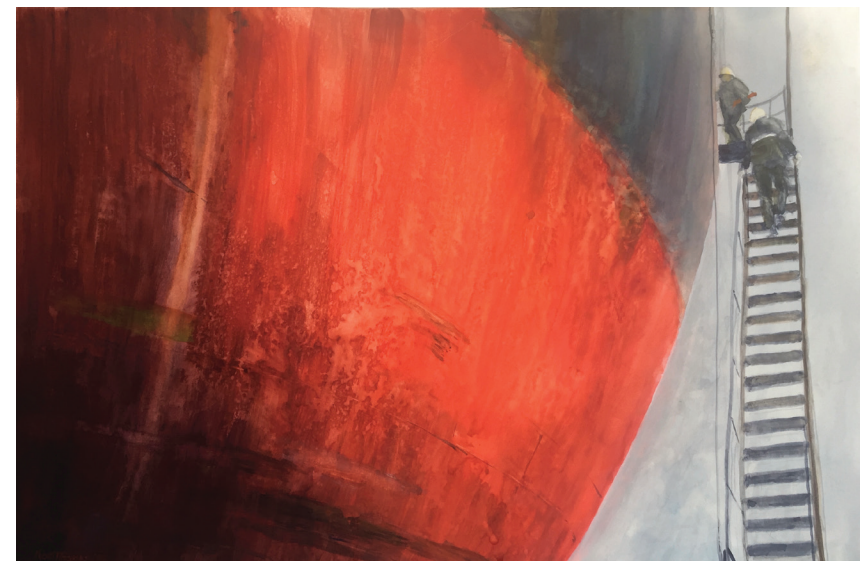
