
'MINIATURES' EXHIBITION SET TO OPEN IN CANNON BEACH

CANNON BEACH — The Cannon Beach Arts Association is celebrating the 35th Anniversary of the "Miniatures" exhibition.


The exhibition features a variety of local and regional artwork. The for-sale miniatures are priced at a measurable difference then larger-scale works.
