21-086VRD: A conditional use request by Annette O'Connor for a two (2) bedroom Vacation Rental Dwelling with a maximum occupancy of six (6) persons regardless of age. The property is located at 420 13th Ave (T6-R10-16DA-TL7600) and it is zoned Medium Density Residential (R2). In conjunction with this request, the applicant is requesting a variance (21-087V) to the rear yard landscaping requirement. The review will be conducted in accordance with Article 6 and Article 10 of the Seaside Zoning Ordinance which establishes the review criteria and procedures for a Conditional Use. The specific review criterion for Vacation Rental Dwellings is included in Section 6.137 of the Ordinance.
