Master Gardener Association offers scholarship

The Clatsop County Master Gardener Association is now seeking applicants for its annual scholarship program for graduating seniors who are residents of Clatsop County, are attending public or private high schools or are home-schooled, and who plan to further their education at a college, university, vocational school or training program.

This year's scholarship fund totals \$2,000, which can be granted in its entirety to one student, or distributed among several students should there be more than one applicant selected. Awards are made based on a student's academic standing and interest in horticulture or a related field.

Applicants must submit a completed application and essay, along with high school

transcripts and two letters of recommendation, and may undergo an interview with members of the CCMGA Scholarship Committee.
