Pacific Unitarian Universalist

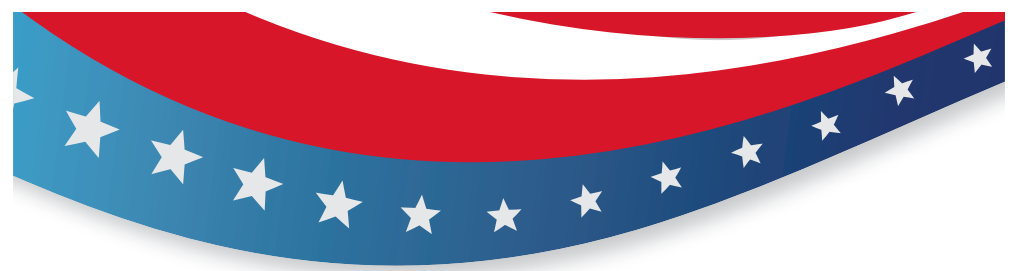

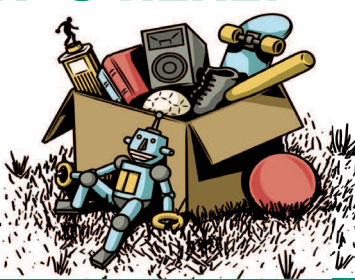
