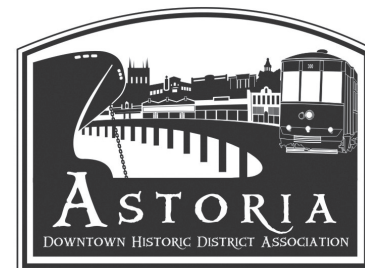
Our 22nd season!
