Discuss Socialism
Sunday evening, May 22, a service of great value was held in the Unitarian church on the subject, "Are We All Socialists?" The aim of the movement is to throw a little more light upon the spirit of this movement so little understood, and as a result so greatly criticized unfavorably. While Mr. MacDonald is not a socialist in any technical sense, he showed that all who are working intelligently for the amelioration of the present conditions of injustice are socialists in the broader meaning. Socialism was defined in some such way as this: An increasing desire to bring in a reign of justice, the determination to put the power into the hands of the people, the effort to make our homes safe from the evils of poverty, the wish to work by agitation and legislation for the equalization of opportunity and the distribution of wealth. In the sense in which we are all working for these things, we are all in sympathy with this intellectual process of socialism. The open discussion at this meeting was educative.

MANY INITIATIVE PETITIONS FILED

Two initiative petitions were presented to the secretary of the state for filing last week. One to change the boundary line between Clackamas county and Multnomah, which will annex to Multnomah nearly all that portion of Clackamas between the present boundary near Sellwood and the Clackamas River. The other petition asks for the creation of Williams county from Douglas and Lane. This county is planned to include some of the same territory included in the petition for the proposed county of Nesmith, which has already been presented to the secretary of the state.

A petition for the creation of Otis county from portions of Grant, Malheur and Harney was also recently filed and it is expected a petition for the creation of Orchard county from northeastern Umatilla county will be filed soon. It is understood that a plan is on foot to square Washington county by adding the east portion to Multnomah.

Six initiative petitions have been presented to the secretary of the state for filing. They are the proposed equal suffrage amendment, the normal school at Monmouth, Otis county, Nesmith county, Williams county and the proposal for changing the boundary between Multnomah and Clackamas counties. A referendum petition has been presented on the bill passed by the last legislature, increasing the salary of Circuit Judge William Smith, in the judicial district in which Baker county is located.

These measures will be filed as soon as the secretary of state's forces can check over the names. It is expected that the total number of initiative measures for the November election will be close to 30. Two years ago there were 19.
