FAREWELL SERMON**

Rev. T. B. Ford, D. D., who has been pastor of Asbury M. E. church for the past year, concluded his work with the local church last Sunday. Large congregations greeted the retiring pastor at both morning and evening services and Dr. Ford preached two masterly sermons that greatly interested his audiences.

During the past year the church has prospered under the pastorate of Rev. Ford. Many new members have been added and a general prosperity prevails in the several branches of church work.

A new church edifice has been begun by the retiring pastor and it was the hope of the church members that he might return to complete its erection and enjoy some of the advantages of service and ministry that the enlarged opportunity for work would afford. Dr. Ford desired to return to complete the work begun, but as the appointment of pastors to churches under the Methodist church polity is wholly arbitrary clergy and laity must do as they are told by the annual conference cabinet.

Dr. Ford has been one of a few of the pastors who has served the local church who has been democratic in his views and who has laid stress on merit and virtue of conduct rather than creed as applied to Christianity for this age.

The services rendered in a public way by the retiring pastor have been appreciated by the citizens of Hood River generally, who regret that he cannot remain here. Dr. Ford requested a supernumerary relation to the church at the last session of the conference and will take a rest for a time before taking up the work elsewhere.

Rev. McOmber, the newly appointed pastor is expected here this week. Mrs. C. H. Sletten and Miss Fay Orr, who have sung in the Congregational church choir for several years, have been engaged to sing in the Methodist church for the ensuing year.

**MANY PRIZES OFFERED
AT THE DALLAS FAIR**

The twentieth annual exhibition of the Second Eastern Oregon Agricultural Society, embracing Hood River and Wasco counties, will be held in The Dalles October 4-8. Cash prizes are being offered for horse racing, horses, cattle, poultry, farm products and fruits.

Fruit entries must consist of at least five specimens of each variety. Among the premiums offered are three prizes for the best general exhibits of apples for the district and also for Hood River county alone. Prizes are offered for the best five named varieties of autumn apples and also winter apples. The best collection of crab apples will receive a prize. Prizes are offered for the best box, commercial pack, of Arkansas Black, Hyde's King, Jonathan, Newtown Pippin, Spitzenburg, Ortley, Winter Banana, Red Cheek Pippin, Northern Spy, King of Tompkins County, Wagener, Delicious and Baldwin. Prizes for plate exhibits of many other varieties are offered. Pears, plums, prunes, peaches, quinces and nuts are also on the list for many prizes.

Premium lists will be sent to any interested parties on receipt of request by Judd S. Fish, secretary, The Dalles, Oregon.

The fair managers announce that free cold storage will be provided for all fruit and vegetables if marked for storage so that exhibits can be forwarded several days before the fair.

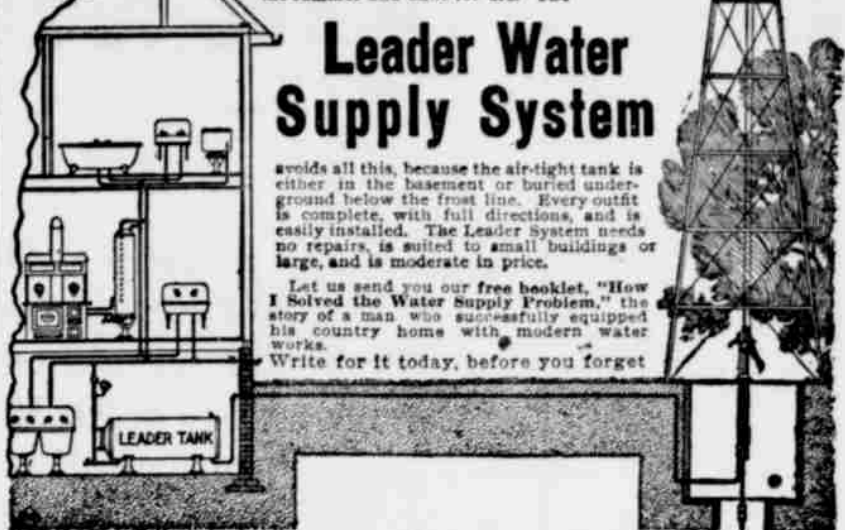
