Thackara: "During the past season American apples in barrels have arrived in Berlin badly damaged, owing to the careless manner in which the fruit was packed. American shippers do apples as in former years. In most cases the barrels contain apples of three or four different sizes and varying greatly in appearance. The top layers are good, while the middle and bottom rows are very different,

both in size and quality. "Apples are imported into Germany packed both in boxes and in barrels, but for the past two years the boxes have been preferred, as the fruit thus packed was received in better condition and the apples were and 1910 11 apples packed in boxes was excellent and well graded and this is hurting the prices. High-grade apples packed in boxes should be wrapped in paper.

'Up to the present time California apples have been received here only in boxes. While they excel in quality the boxed apples from eastern states, the packing and quality of the Oregon and Washington fruit were superior. In my opinion the German trade in American barrel apples will decrease from year to year on account of the faulty packing and grading of the fruit, I am also of the opinion that the imports of American apples into this country would increase enormously if the prevailing defects could be eliminated and the American shippers would send only apples in good condition and free from San Jose scale."

### MUST DO THEIR OWN ICING AS WELL AS PRE-COOLING

An additional order has been is sued by the Interstate Commerce Commission covering the case of the pre-cooling by shippers of California citrus fruits. By this later ruling the shippers, in order to avail themselves of the reduction in pre-cooling charges on oranges and lemons from \$30 to \$7,50 a car, recently made by the commission, must, in addition to doing their own pre-cooling, also do their own leing. It is very difficult to obtain and keep ice in Southern California. It, of course, would be possible for the California Fruit Growers' exchange to establish its own ice manufacturing plant, as on shipments of 15,000 to 20,000 cars annually, the saving on the pre-cooling charge would run from \$350,000 to \$450,000. Smaller shippers, however, could not afford to own their own ice plants. This late ruling may be found to work to the advantage of the exchange
