GIVES REMEDY FOR SALMON POISONING
A bulletin just issued by the Oregon State Board of Health is largely devoted to experiments made for the purpose of discovering the exact cause of dogs becoming poisoned by eating salmon, and also to determine a procedure for curative treatment. The results of the experiments were successful. It was found that the portions of a salmon that cause dog poisoning are more especially the congealed blood along the back bone and the kidneys.
Various breeds of dogs were experimented on and, "there appears," says the bulletin, "to be a marked degree of difference in the susceptibility of dogs of different breeds. The hounds seem to be particularly susceptible, collies and shepherd dogs next, then the bird dogs and finally the common mongrel, which seems to be the least susceptible. The partial insusceptibility or immunity of the latter may be due to common dogs eating fish partially sterilized in cooked food that they obtain from garbage."
A dog that has been well salmoned and recovers from the disease, is immunized against subsequent attacks. This has been confirmed by many owners of dogs. The bulletin notes that "the first noticeable symptom of the disease occurs invariably nine days after the fish has been eaten. The dog becomes morose, desires to lie down, and refuses to take food."
"If the temperature be taken previous to appearance of first symptom it will be found to rise from normal, 101.102 F., to 105.3 on the seventh day, gradually decreasing from the eighth day to subnormal, where it remains slightly fluctuating until death, but never rising to the normal or maximum again."
"During the course of low temper-

ature the dog appears to be cold and curls up as though suffering from abdominal pains. No food is taken after the first symptoms appear, but there is a constant desire to drink, which, if allowed, is followed by vomiting."
The affected dog then develops bowel trouble which grows gradually worse ending in convulsions and causing death.
As a result of several cures effected by Prof. Emile F. Penot a simple remedy has been discovered for the treatment of canines affected with salmon poisoning. The remedy is calomel. "The most effective time for administering the calomel is about the third day after the first symptoms have been observed, or after the dog has appeared very sick and vomiting."
"The efficiency of calomel as a specific for salmon poisoning has been repeatedly verified by dog owners. Reports have been received from the same owner of six recoveries out of eight cases, two of the dogs that died having other complications."
"Our experience," concludes the bulletin, "has been that if the calomel is given in the last stages of the disease it causes intense suffering owing to the highly inflamed condition of the intestines, and the dog being in such a weak, emaciated condition usually dies from exhaustion, in a short time."
As the death of valuable dogs is frequently caused by salmon poisoning, the discovery of a remedy will no doubt be highly appreciated by dog fanciers.
