

NEW MEXICO CLAIMS FIRST APPLE TREES

"The Garden of Eden was located in New Mexico and some of the original apple trees are still standing. This is the claim made by many people of one of the newest states in the Union, and New Mexico is making considerable noise about the matter recently, due to the activity in the apple districts of that state in preparation for the American apple exposition which will be held in Denver the week of November 12. Apples from these trees will be exhibited at the show.

Of course the counter claim is made that the aforesaid apple trees were planted or, rather, grew from seeds planted by the Spanish invaders some three hundred years ago. Be that as it may, the trees are standing near the town of Manzano, which is the Spanish word for apple, and in the vicinity of the old ruins of Cuara, Abo and Grand Quivira. And it must be admitted that the apples that will be exhibited from these trees at the Denver show will be a classy display.

Legend has it that the original settlers were driven out of the country or killed by the Comanche Indians or other tribes of savages that infested that section. When the Mexicans resettled the country about one hundred years ago they found the trees still standing and bearing fruit, and they named the town Manzano. So the fact is undisputed that the trees are at least more than one hundred years old.

The management of the apple show has decided to hold a Garden of Eden wedding one night during the show. The given name of the groom must be Adam and that of the bride, Eve. It such a couple can be found in any state on the American continent, the ceremony will be performed on a stage in the center of the big Auditorium, where it will be witnessed by 12,000 people, which is the capacity of the building. The couple will be given a handsome wedding present and also will be presented with the apples from the trees which are said, by some people, to have stood in the Garden of Eden.

OCTOBER REPORT SHOWS LESS FRUIT

October's estimate, by the federal government, of apple crop conditions throughout the United States, it is said, justifies the healthier tone manifested by good fruit in eastern markets. The estimate, according to the experts of the Department of Agriculture, is 52.8 per cent of normal, which is 3.4 per cent less than in September; 6.4 more than for the same period last year, and four-tenths of one per cent more than the ten year averages for October.

Distributors admit that the percentage now over the figure of last year is comprised of early fall apples, and that good-keeping winter varieties are probably less in quantity at present than at this time last year.

CARPENTERS' FEUD RESULTS IN DEATH

Dave Mannausaw was shot and instantly killed at The Dalles Friday morning by Fred Eveland. Both men were carpenters.

The trouble was the result of a quarrel over rent. Mannausaw was renting a tent to Eveland, in which the latter and his family lived, Mannausaw and his family living in a tent nearby. There was some misunderstanding over the collection of the rent and Mannausaw went to Eveland's tent and began abusing him. Eveland seized a revolver and began shooting, all five of the shots fired taking effect in Mannausaw's body, causing instant death.

Arthur Sanburn, a step-son of Mannausaw, awakened by the shooting, ran out and took two shots at Eveland, but both went wild. Eveland went to The Dalles and gave himself up, claiming that he shot in self-defense. Sanburn was arrested and will be held for trial in connection with the shooting.
