the base line, thence east on the base line to the southeast corner of township 1 north, range 9 E. W. M., thence north along the east boundary of said township to the southeast corner of section 24, said township and range, thence east 2 miles to the

southeast corner of section 29, township 1 north, range 10 E. W. M., thence northerly 4 miles to township line, thence west 1 mile, thence north to the point of beginning.

The new boundaries of Odell, Baldwin, East and Center are as follows: Odell—Beginning at the southeast corner of section 1, township 1 north, range 10 E. W. M., thence west 4 miles to the northeast corner of section 6, said township and range, thence northerly 1 mile along the

east boundary of section 5 to township line, thence west 1 mile, thence north to the stream of Hood River, thence down said stream to its intersection with the north and south center line of section 14, township 2 north, range 10 E. W. M., thence north to the south line of section 26, township 3 north, range 10 E. W. M., thence south on said line to the center of section 23, said township and range, thence east one-half mile, south one and one-half miles, thence east 1 mile, thence southerly to the point of beginning.

Baldwin—Beginning at the southeast corner of township 3 south, range 10 E. W. M., thence north 15 miles to the base line, thence west 1 mile to the southeast corner of township 1 north, range 10 E. W. M., thence north on the east line of said township 5 miles, thence west to the southwest corner of section 4, township 1 north, range 10 E. W. M., thence south 3 miles, thence west 2 miles, thence south 2 miles, thence west on base line to the northeast corner of township 1 south, range 9 E. W. M., thence south on west line of said township to the southwest corner thereof, thence west to the west boundary line of Hood River county, thence southerly along said boundary line to the southwest corner of Hood River county, thence east to the point of beginning.

Hood River Center—Beginning at the intersection of the stream of Hood River with the north and south center line of section 14, township 2 north, range 10 E. W. M., thence north to the south line of section 26, township 3 north, range 10 E. W. M., thence east to Paradise Ave., thence east on Morris Ave. to Twelfth street, thence south on 12th street to Lena street, thence east on Lena street to Sherman Ave. and east on Sherman Ave. to its intersection with the Serpentine road, thence easterly on said road to its intersection with Fourth street, thence south on Fourth street to May street, thence east on May street to A Third street, thence south on A Third St. to the center of section 36, township 3 north, range 10 E. W. M., thence east to the stream of Hood River, thence up said stream to the point of beginning.

East Hood River—Beginning at the southeast corner of section 9, township 2 north, range 11 E. W. M., thence west three miles, thence north one-fourth mile, thence west to the stream of Hood River, thence down said stream to its intersection with the east and west center line of section 30, township 3 north, range 10 E. W. M., thence west to the center of said section 36, thence north to May street, thence west on May street to Fourth street, thence north on Fourth street to its intersection with the Serpentine Road, thence northerly on said road to its intersection with Sherman Ave., thence east on Sherman Ave. to its intersection with Third street projected south, thence north to Columbia river, thence easterly along the south bank of said river to the east boundary line of Hood River county, thence south on said boundary line to the point of beginning.

SHARP-ROBERTSON CASE  
TO BE TRIED AT HOOD RIVER

The case of E. F. Sharp vs. W. H. Robertson and the U. S. Fidelity & Guaranty Co., which was set for trial at Portland, in Multnomah county on the 20th inst., has been brought to Hood River county for trial.

This is an action brought by E. F. Sharp to recover \$5000 damages off Mr. Robertson and the Surety Company because Mr. Robertson contracted to clear 60 acres of land for Mr. Sharp, near Parkdale, for \$6,000, and the Surety company went his bond for the faithful performance of the contract, and Mr. Robertson was unable to clear the land for that amount of money. S. W. Stark is the attorney for Mr. Robertson and the Surety company, and Attorneys Huntington and Wilson, of Portland, represent Mr. Sharp.
