**LIVE NEWS FROM AROUND THE STATE**

Greater Portland will rank among the world's great harbors and seaports, according to the report of the board of New York harbor engineers which has been received and opened by the public docks commission.

Strawberries—the first of the season—are here. The initial offering of the fruit in Portland, which necessarily is a very limited one, comes from Los Angeles, and the berries, of course, retail at a price that makes them a luxury. The few dealers who are so fortunate as to be supplied in a small way are asking 40 cents a box for the fruit.

Absolute simplicity and a limit of \$7.50 has been placed as the principal features of the graduating dresses of the Medford high school; while they must be as devoid of frills and ruffles as the artistic young woman can force herself to endure. All the young people in the domestic science classes will be given an opportunity to make their gowns during the school periods.

March was an unusually busy month at the United States land office in Burns, a total of \$2,545.19 acres of the public domain, almost all in Harney county, having been appropriated during the time. The entries included 40 homesteads, embracing 7381.69 acres; 16 desert, 2884.52 acres; 38 soldiers' declaratory, 6969.52 acres; state selection for the Warner lake irrigation project, 26,350.39 acres and one railroad selection of 40 acres.

Orchardists throughout the Rogue River valley smudged the last of the week for the first time this Spring. Pears are in full blossom, 10 days later than last year, and never looked better at this stage.

One hundred thousand dollars was subscribed by stockmen, ranchers, landowners and business men in and around Prineville for the purpose of inducing the Hill interests to build a branch railroad line from Metolun or some similarly well-situated point on the line of the Oregon Trunk, to tap the interior.

**CAMPAIGNERS ARE EXPECTED HERE**

A week from next Friday Republican voters of Oregon will decide between Taft, LaFollette and Roosevelt. In the meantime Hood River is scheduled to hear a Taft speaker, Ralph D. Cole of Ohio, a LaFollette speaker, Walter L. Houser of Wisconsin, and unless present plans go awry LaFollette himself will speak here, probably the first of next week.

The bombardment in behalf of candidates opened in full force this week when Walter L. Houser of Wisconsin took the stump in Oregon for LaFollette, while Ralph D. Cole, former congressman from Ohio, and Rev. John Wesley Hill of New York invaded the state in praise of Taft. At the last of the week LaFollette himself will arrive and speakers of renown for Roosevelt are also expected before the campaign grows much older.

Arrangements are being made for several meetings for Houser in southern Oregon, beginning with Ashland, where he probably will speak Monday night. Cole is due to arrive in Portland Monday night and make his first speech at McMinnville Tuesday night. His other dates are at Hillsboro Wednesday night, Hood River on Thursday, The Dalles on Friday, Pendleton on Saturday and Enterprise, La Grande, Baker and Ontario for the succeeding nights of the last week.

LaFollette will speak in Portland on Monday or Tuesday, April 15 or 16.
