This right of way is granted on condition that if at any time the railroad company in constructing, operating, and maintaining its railroad shall seriously interfere with the use of the road for public travel, the county court may, upon giving the railroad sixty days' notice, demand the removal of such railroad, and in no case shall the railroad have the use of the public road for right of way purposes for more than three years.
