## The Ale List

### 64 oz. taproom and growler station opens

A packed house for Saturday's soft opening gave Lorraine Lyons and Rod Steward a sense of what to expect at their new tap room, 64 oz.

Located at 110 Third St., 64 oz. opens Thursday at 11:30 a.m., and will be open until a "to-be-determined" closing time, seven days a week.

While centrally situated among the downtown core breweries and taprooms, 64 oz. is the first full-scale growler station in this beer-everent burg.

"We're dedicated to the concept. You can come in and sit down at a table or pull up to a loading zone, stop, come in and get out," Lyons said.

The 30 taps include a nitro, and all along the line is a selection of local and Northwest ales, and a regular selection of four or more ciders. Enjoy a pint in or take it to go; growler fills are mostly in the \$11-\$12 range, depending on the selection. Growler glass (32- and 64-ounce, natch) are available for \$4 and \$6.

Lyons, an insurance consultant, and Steward, a drummer and former IT guy, bring their love of craft beer to the shop they hope will be "a comfortable community spot." Live music is planned;

snacks are available but take-in food is encouraged from downtown restaurants and food trucks. Indoor seating includes communal and two-top seats on the ground-floor and mezzanine seats, and five or six places at the bar. Outdoor seating is planned this summer.

#### Session Cream Ale debuts

Next in Full Sail Brewing's Session Series lineup is the newly released Session Cream Summer Ale. It's a classic American beer in a classic American bottle just in time to celebrate American Craft Beer Week (May 11-17). Session Cream Ale pours with a rich golden hue with aromas of citrus and herbal hops backed with a smooth malty/sweet mid-palate, finishing cleanly with hints of citrus and caramel. Session Cream is available in 12-packs and on nitro-draft all summer long. (ABV 5.4, IBU 26.)

New names, same good beer: two downtown beer bars are in the process of re-branding: The Pint Shack is metamorphing into The Moth Lounge, and Horse and Hound (aka "The British Pub") has been renamed Oak Street Pub.
