Mid-Columbia Community Choir Ladies Chorus is a gorge based ladies group formed in 2013 and made up of 18 ladies who are members of the larger choir. Each month the ladies visit one of several local care facilities singing for shut-ins and bring their message of hope through music. They have performed bedside concerts for individuals and families in hospice care.

The Ladies Chorus will perform classical to contemporary pieces including "Amazing Grace," a well-known hymn and "Merrick," an 18th century piece both written by John Newton. The chorus also will perform Dr. Mack Wilberg's classical arrangement of "My Shepherd Will Supply My Need" and the opening them of the popular animated musical Frozen entitled, "Eatnemen Vuelie."

The program will feature two solos: Stephenie Gross singing, "You Are Good," and Anita Decker singing, "Your Grace Still Amazes Me."
