Chris Emerson

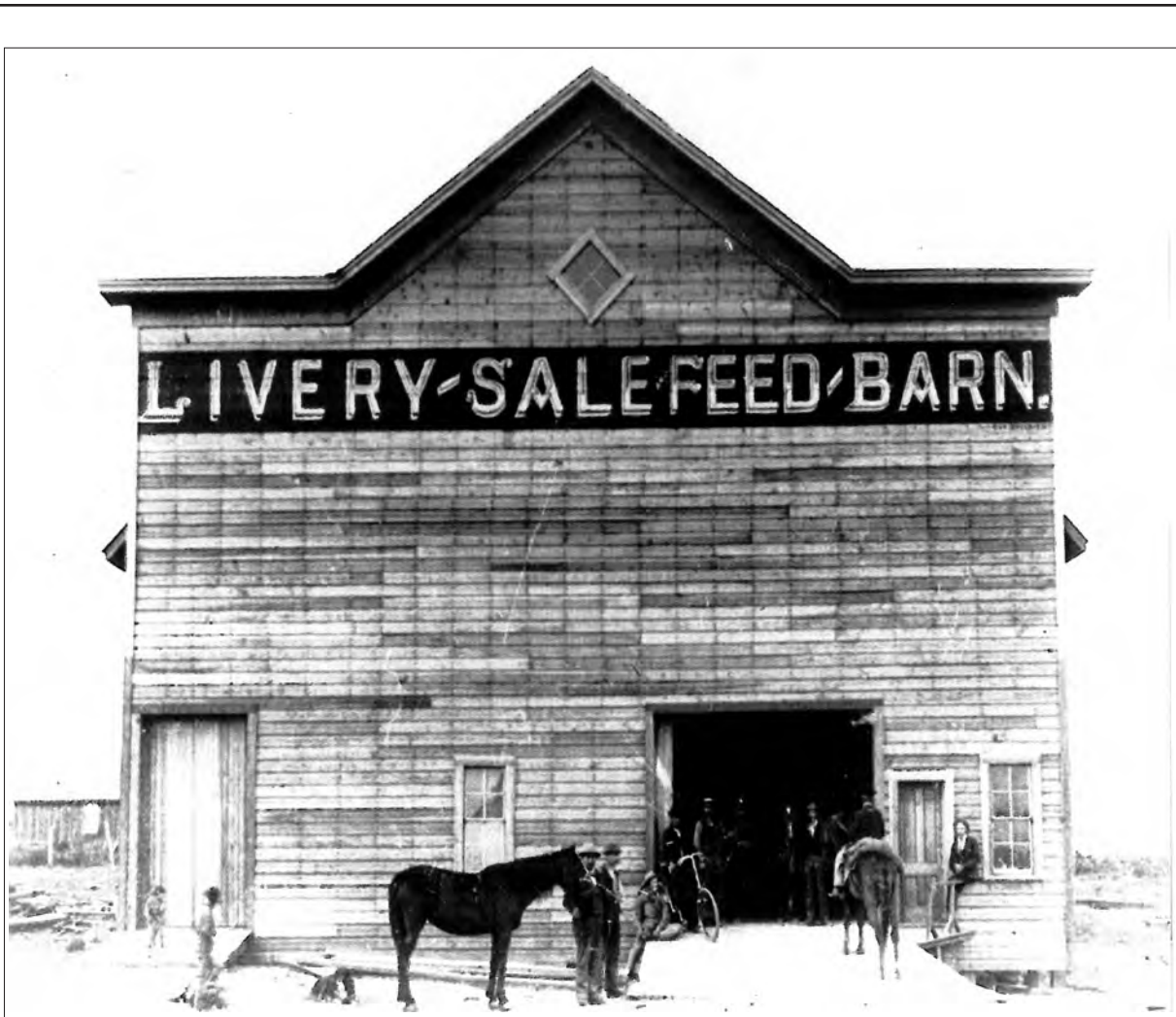
Chris Emerson, beloved husband, father, grandfather, brother and friend, passed away May 23, 2015.
