

COR. FIFTH AND PINE STS., PORTLAND, Oregon GALUSHA A. GROW, OLDEST MAN IN CONGRESS.



Congressman Galusha A. Grow, the oldest member of Congress, celebrated golden jubilee the other day. It is just fifty years ago since he first became a member of the national legislative body. In the last half century he has been elected and re-elected to Congress twelve times, being defeated once-in 1862when a gerrymander threw him into a new and strange district. Previous to that he had served six terms, three as a Free Soil Democrat and three as a Republican. At one of these elections previous to his one defeat he received every vote cast in his district, there being no opposition. He was Speaker of the House during the first two years of the Civil War. When he entered Congress in 1851 he was the youngest member. In his third and fifth terms he was chairman of the important committee on territories. In 1894 he was chosen one of the two members-at-large for the State, and has since been re-elected with increasing pluralities, once with a plurality of 297,446, the largest ever given a candidate for any office in any State. Mr. Grow was born in 1823 in Susquehanna County, Pa. His father died when he was 3, and his primary education was received at winter school after the farm labor of the summer was done with. Later he was enabled to attend Amherst College, and graduated from that institution in 1844. His home is at Glenwood. From 1871 to 1876 he was president of the International and Great Northern Railroad.


