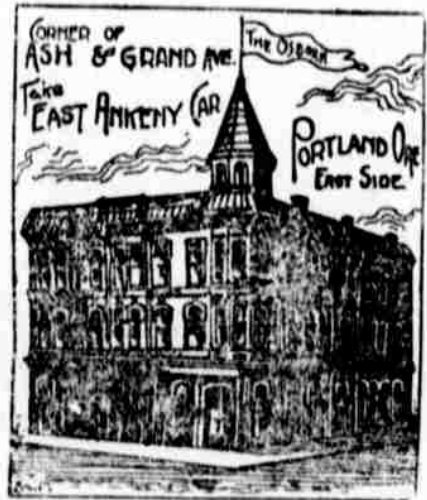

QUEEN DRAGA OF SERVIA. Who is Now Said to Be Plotting to Steal the Throne. Queen Draga, of Servia, who is charged with plotting to steal the throne for her sister's infant son, whom she is trying to pass off as her own on young King Alexander, is a wonderfully astute woman, who has defeated the Serb parliament, the powers of Europe and the bitter hatred of the former Queen Natalie in every joust she has had with them. Draga was formerly a maid of Natalie, mother of the young king. Although very much older than he, she won his love and was married to him in spite of the fact that Natalie and Milan resorted to no end of intrigue to stop him, and in spite of the fact that his parliament threatened to revolt. The czar finally consented and the former maid took her place on the throne which her former mistress had occupied. Draga is said to be so unpopular in Servia that she does not like to appear in public. Her influence over young Alexander is all powerful, and thus far she has won in all her contests with the people. Her father was a colonel in the Russian army, and through his influence she was given her place at the court of Queen Natalie.
