

STREMBOD ACCIDENT.—We learn from Capt. Gibson and Col. A. P. Dennison, that the new steamboat, "Venture," built by R. B. Thompson & Co., at the Cascades, west on the falls on Tuesday, the 11th inst., in going over, one man jumped overboard and was drowned. The boat, over the falls, lodged upon a rock opposite the middle block house, where she remained until the 19th inst., when she came off, and was picked up by the steamboat "Mountain Duck," and was towed to the shore, where she now lies. The extent of the injuries to the boat are not yet ascertained. The cause of the accident, we understand, was a misunderstanding between the Captain and the Engineer. We further learn, that it is damaged beyond repair, the proprietors will commence building another boat immediately.
