The sixth section of the Act of Congress entitled An Act to reduce the expenses of the Survey of the Public Lands in the United States, Approved May 30th. 1862, is as follows:

"SECTION 6. And be it further enacted, That from and after the first day of July next the compensation of Registers and Receivers in all the Land Offices in the United State shall be an annual salary of five hundred dollars each, with the fees and commissions now prescribed by law and, to be past by claimants, an additional fee in donation cases of five dollars for each final crifficate of one hundred and sixty acres, ten dollars for three hundred and twenty acres, and fifteen dollars for six hundred and forty acres.
