

OFFICIAL.] LAWS OF THE UNITED STATES, PASSED AT THE First Session of the Thirty-Eighth Congress. [Public-No. 200.] An act to correct a clerical error in the law of June 30, 1864, relating to the Post Office Department.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That so much of the Act of 30th June, 1864, as repeals the 17th, 18th, 35th, 39th, and 41st sections of the Act of March 3, 1863, entitled "An act to amend the laws relating to the Postoffice Department," be, and the same is hereby, repealed.
