NEW TORK, Peb. 6.—The stock market re-tained its general characteristics today of dreath and breach. A large outside interest was manifest, and the professional operators who bought at the lower level were bury in bid-ding up the prices of their boldings and in Beeling the new demand to take their profile; but, while selling stocks from the one hand to reality on the rise, they were taking on new kollings of different stocks with the other. Ap-parently the confluence that stocks which had not yet shared in the advance could be induced to move upward was unimpared, and the hold-ings of the large financial interests which have ings of the large financial interests which have taken hold of the market were hexademed and essential. The duration of this kind of upward movement does not alwars depend scrietly on the continuance of the public demand for stocks.
