SIX BURNED TO DEATH

TWO OTHERS INJURED IN NEW YORK LODGING-HOUSE FIRE.

It Was in the Cheap Bowery Section, and Property Loss Was Only About \$2000.

NEW YORK, March 4.—Six persons were burned to death and two were injured early this morning in a fire which occurred in a ten-story lodging-house at 44 to 46 Bowery. The dead are: Charles Buttle, 40 years old; John Clark, 30 years old; Edward Doyle, 25 years old; Henry Jackson (colored) 35 years old. One unidentified man about 30 years old; Stephen Carney, 35 years old; and a woman, 25 years old, who was burned about the face and hands, and also removed to the hospital.
