BETTER LOGIC THAN DICTION

Portland Japanese Editor Publishes Rules for Cleanliness.

The Japanese residents of this city approve of the orders issued by the Health Commissioner in regard to cleaning up and purifying their dwellings and premises. Yesterday the editor of the Japanese paper published here left with the Health Board the following list of rules, which he intends to publish for the guidance of his countrymen in this matter:

1. Don't keep rats in your dwelling—kill them as soon as possible. Mind your cats and dogs to be in good health.
2. Keep your premises clean, sewers, boxes or pails. Burn up all the dirt and everything dry; don't allow them to moist.
3. Each person must wear clothes or night suits enough to prevent catch a bad cold.
4. Care must be taken on your foods. Never eat stale or old stuffs, especially old fishes. Don't touch Clab or Funa, a kind of river fish that easily take the Bacillus.
5. Don't drink more than two glasses of water at once.
6. Your attention should be paid on your daily life toward the clean. Rooms, closets and basement must always be swept and kept airy.

TWO HOURS OF PERIL.

Two Steamboat Inspectors at the Mercy of Wednesday's Storm.

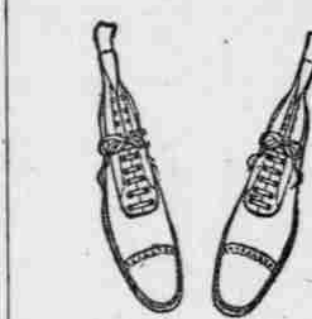

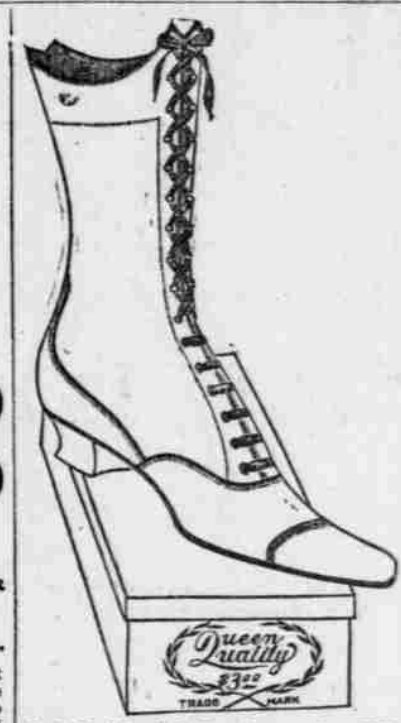
