THE IRRIGATION OF THE ORCHARD. The first year we irrigate twice each month until August 15. The water in run in furrows on each side of the tree row at first about 10 inches from the trees.

THE IRRIGATION OF THE ORCHARD (continued). We usually let a small stream run 12 hours. Water is regulated by small boxes made of lath, which are cut in the center or two feet long, nailed so as to make a funnel one inch square.
