DRYDOCK SPRINGS A LEAK Large Amount of Damage Caused in the Brooklyn Navy-Yard. NEW YORK, July 31.—Drydock No. 3, at the Brooklyn navy-yard, which is being repaired at an estimated expenditure of \$1,000,000, sprang a leak today.

NEW 2 PER CENT BONDS. Over \$320,000,000 of the Old Issues Surrendered. WASHINGTON, July 31.—The Secretary of the Treasury today began sending out the new 2 per cent bonds due in 1903, which are to take the place of such of the old 4 per cent bonds as have been offered for extension at the new rate under the currency act of March 1, 1900.

NEW NATIONAL BANKS. Since March, 426 Applications for Charters Have Been Made. WASHINGTON, July 31.—The record of the office of the Controller of the Currency shows that since March 1 last the Controller has approved 426 applications to organize National banks, of which 227 have since been organized and have begun business.
