RAISING A RANSOM

Nearly \$100 Contributed for Arthur Venville.

EVERYBODY GAVE CHEERFULLY

Money Will Be Sent to General MacArthur, Who Will Publish Reward Throughout Luzon.

More than one-third of the amount asked by Lieutenant A. N. Wood for the offer of a ransom for the boy, Arthur Venville, was raised in one day. People everywhere responded gratefully to the call. Everybody recognizes that this is the most distressing and useful form of patriotism. If this brave boy still lives he cannot receive a higher service than rescue from the hands of his semi-savage captors. Lieutenant Wood was more than pleased with the cordial response in which the people came forward with funds. He is confident that within another day or two he will have the full amount of \$500 deemed necessary to offer a suitable reward.

Some persons are disposed to question the practicability of the idea. They argue that it will be very difficult to get the information that a ransom is offered to the Philippines that may be holding the boy a prisoner. For this reason they hesitate to act. One man said yesterday: "If I knew the money could be placed where it would be an inducement to the Filipinos who may be holding young Venville, I would give almost anything. That would be a case no man with a heart could refuse."

Lieutenant Wood believes that the money can be placed where it will have exactly this effect. There are American garages over most of Luzon, and particularly wherever the Tagals are found. Any one who has read late reports will see that even the insurgents themselves, while in actual possession of the American lines at all. The number of the Filipinos in arms is very small compared to the whole population. Filipinos know as much about what the Americans are doing as the Americans know themselves. If the soldiers while spying in citizen clothes do not get the information, the spies Filipinos learn it and report to their commanders. This state of affairs places all the Filipinos who are intelligent as the Tagals in close communication with the American forces. General Fournier penetrated the island to Baler, the place where Venville was captured, and garilleros have been stationed in many places in that district. Lieutenant Wood intends to have the money sent to General MacArthur, with a request to have the commanding officers of all these posts notified and instructed to circulate the news among the Filipinos. Circulars may be printed in Tagalog and Spanish. If so they will be distributed everywhere in Luzon. The offer of such a reward will certainly bring to light positive information, if it does not produce the brave boy alive and well.

A very interesting letter was received by The Oregonian yesterday concerning Venville. It was written by F. F. Jancke, of the Forbes-Jancke Co., druggists, at the corner of Hawthorne and Grand avenues, and is as follows: "Portland, Aug. 12.—(To the Editor.)—Inclosed please find a check for \$250, which kindly add to the fund being raised to ransom young Venville. Two young girls, whose quiet and ladylike deportment was ever noticeable, had been in the habit of waiting for an Oregon City car in our store frequently. One Winter day some three years ago I noticed them in the company of a young sailor lad in his regulation uniform, as usual waiting for a car at our corner, and on inquiry of them I learned this was their brother, Arthur Venville, then serving on the U. S. S. Adams, and temporarily on a furlough visiting his mother. I have seen the young man only on this occasion, but have a vivid recollection of him, and was particularly impressed with his handsome and manly features. This case should appeal to the heart of every citizen as one deserving special interest, and I am sure that this small contribution would, in case of eventual success, tenfold repay."
