Yesterday was a quiet day on the street. Dealers of Puget Sound watermelons are still heavy, but there is a considerable amount of stock. Local demand and the call from Gray's Harbor and the country between Portland and Puget Sound keep watermelons on the move. To add to the already large supply of peaches, a carload of fine stock came in from Snake River. Owing to the large supply of peaches, prices are not so firm. Inferior grades continue low, but best commanded 4 1/2 and 5 cents. A new factor in the peach market is the crop in the large crop raised in the vicinity of Portland. Eggs and best creamery butter continue firm. Foultry is dull. There is no change in the wheat situation.
