COULD NOT FACE THE LAW.

Woman Arrested for Violation of the Postal Laws, Commits Suicide.

PEORIA, III., Sept. 14 .- Mrs. Alice Maud Newland, formerly of Forest, III., shot hereelt through the heart last evening at the Newland residence, at Galesburg, having previously been arrested with her husband, Dr. Frederick M. Newland, charged with violating the United States postal laws by sending through the mails rculars advocating the oriminal use of drugs manufactured by them under the name of the De Floraine Company, which had quarters at Buffalo, Galesh and other cities. United States Com-missioner Humphrey, of Chicago, issued the warrant and has been accumulating

A few minutes before the time to take the train for Cunton for the preliminary examination, Mrs. Newland asked to go to her room. Hearing the shot fired. h husband and United States Marshal Tripp broke open the door and found the woman dead. The husband was held in \$1200 for a bearing and will be to the Peoria jail today.

Montana Murderer Hanged.

BUTTE, Mont., Sept. 14 .- Daniel Lucey was hanged in the jail yard here at 11:08 this morning for the murder of Patrick L. Rengan, The two men had started for the Coeur d'Alenes together, and Beagan's body was found in the canyon next day. Lucey was caught at Victor, Colo., brought back and convicted on nircumstantial evidence. It was the first legal hanging here in 12 years. Lucey Lucey protested his innocence to the last.
