VANCOUVER LINE EXTENSION

SURVEY COMPLETED FIFTEEN MILES BEYOND PRESENT TERMINUS. VANCOUVER, Wash., Dec. 13.—The Portland, Vancouver & Yakima Railroad and the Columbia River and Puget Sound Railway have completed the survey of a 15-mile extension of the line from the present northern terminus, near Bayview, to a point about four miles north of Westport.
