

SHOT OLD SWEETHEART

WALLA WALLA, June 13.—Crazed by reading sensational literature, and blind with jealous passion, William Davis, a bootblack, at 5:30 o'clock this afternoon, twice shot his former sweetheart, 17-year-old Edie Haworth, and then turned the smoking revolver upon Charles McConnell, his successful rival. After the shooting, Davis ran toward the business portion of the city, with a crowd of boys and women at his heels. He flourished a revolver and declared he would not be taken alive. Mrs. Haworth was shot once through the left breast and a second time in the back, the weapon used being a .38-caliber revolver. She is lying at the point of death at her home, and attending physicians declare there is not one chance in 10 of her recovering her consciousness. Charles McConnell tells the following story of the shooting:

"I was standing talking with Miss Haworth and Davis, who has been attempting to go with her for some time, approached and asked if he might speak with her alone. She accompanied him a distance of 20 feet and talked with him for perhaps 10 minutes. Suddenly he drew a gun and exclaimed: 'By God, I'll kill you then.' I started toward them, but he pointed the revolver at her and pulled the trigger. She pushed the weapon aside and it missed her. Then he again pointed it. She was turning toward me as the pistol exploded and the ball passed through her breast. She started to run and he fired twice more, hitting her in the left forearm, and pushed the muzzle of the pistol against my breast and snatched it again. He then said the weapon was defective and there was no explosion. He then started to run and I turned to assist the girl."

COUNT ON BIG HOP CROP.

Salem Growers, However, Put State Yield at \$5,000 Less.

SALEM, Ore., June 13.—Although the weather has been cool so far this season, hops have made satisfactory growth, and promise a splendid crop. What effect the warm weather will have upon them is uncertain. The continued rain has made the vines so tender that training them on the wires has been almost impossible; but it is not probable that any injury will result from this.

There has been some talk of a crop of 300,000 bales of hops in this state, but this estimate is regarded as far too high.

James Winslow, a Kaiser Bottom grower, and the other growers have made a statement that the crop will be 200,000 bales, if the present outlook continues. This is the most common estimate, and is 200 bales more than the crop of last year. Of course, it is too early to make estimates with any pretension to certainty, for adverse conditions may prevail. The ground and under-flooding have caused the continued wet weather, which may bring on hoplice, which could do some damage. Growers, however, look for a big crop, of good quality and the best price that has been paid for several years.

Farmers' Meeting at Monmouth.

MONMOUTH, June 13.—C. L. Smith, of Minnesota, who is making a tour of the Willamette Valley in the interest of diversified farming for the Southern Pacific Company, was here yesterday, and addressed a meeting of farmers in the afternoon. Mr. Smith remarked that the farmers in the Willamette Valley should do more thinking, and adopt better methods. As proof, he referred to Minnesota, where dairying and diversified crops have supplanted wheat-growing in a profitable way. Mr. Smith said that the farmers should give facts and figures as to the amount and kind of feed for all kinds of stock, and the cost of raising them. Mr. Smith took care to say that he has found some good business farmers in the Willamette Valley. Questions were asked by those present, and the meeting was a highly interesting one.

RICH STRIKE AT KALAMA.

Darnell Mine Will Work Three Shifts a Day.

KALAMA, June 13.—The Darnell Mining & Milling Company, of Kalama, is pushing development in its mine in the upper end of town with all possible speed, working three shifts a day. The force will be employed until the true value of the strike is known. The company will now run a cross-cut, having struck a body of phonolite. O. M. Ridenale, metallurgical and mining engineer of Portland, after a careful examination of the mine, reports that "the phonolite is virtually the door to the treasure vault, and that a very rich body of ore may be looked for as soon as the drift has cut through it." A chemical analysis of the ore on the upper side of hanging wall of the phonolite gave a result of 61 cents copper, 22 cents silver, and 1 cent gold and titanium in paying quantities.
