CAUSE OF LI'S DEATH

Violent Dispute With Lessor, the Russian Minister, OVER THE MANCHURIAN TREATY

The Aged Viceroy, After a Stormy Interview, Went Home in a Passion and Had a Hemorrhage, Which Resulted Fatally.

PEKIN, Nov. 8.—A violent dispute with Paul Lessor, Russian Minister to China, over the Manchurian treaty, appears to have been the immediate cause of the death of Li Hung Chang.

While these things were happening in Peking, the southern viceroys sent to the Empress Dowager a memorial against the treaty.

The flag of the United States Legation was the only one half-masted in Peking today. The mourners and the family of Li Hung Chang will have paper offerings tomorrow, in accordance with the custom for the use of his spirit in the other world.

Yuan Shi Kai's successor in the Governorship of Shan Tung Chang Yen Chou, is an unknown person.

Twenty-eighth Infantry Packing Up at Vancouver.

WILL GO TO THE PHILIPPINES Major Ronch Will Be in Command of Troops to Sail From Portland

VANCOUVER, Wash., Nov. 8.—Major Ronch now at Boise Barracks, Idaho, will be in command of the four companies of the Twenty-eighth Infantry which will sail from Portland for the Philippines on the transport Rosecrans November 15.

Evidence of the marching orders are to be seen on every hand at Vancouver Barracks. The "packing up" is about at an end, and the baggage and freight will be shipped to San Francisco at once.
