

CAUSED BY DENSE FOG

PARIS, Nov. 17.—During the greater part of today, Paris and its suburbs were shrouded in a dense fog, which seriously interfered with railway transportation and vehicular traffic, and caused a number of minor accidents. The fog was so thick that the St. Nazaire steamboats were compelled to suspend service.
