

NEW SETTLERS' RATE

ANNOUNCED BY O. R. & N. FOR USE IN THE SPRING.

25 Second-Class Fare From Omaha and Kansas City to North Pacific Common Points.

The O. R. & N. Co. yesterday announced that a rate of \$25 for second-class passage would be made between Omaha and Kansas City, in the East, and Portland and Puget Sound points, on this coast, next March and April.

The Great Northern took the initiative in putting in settlers' rates three years ago, and the other lines between the Missouri River and the North Pacific common points soon followed suit.
